The local Super Shooter competition hosted by the Fremont Jaycees was held on Sunday, March 20th at Linden Elementary School. Super Shooters is an individual timed basketball event for boys and girls ages 6-13 and is free to participants.

Fifty five boys and girls competed in four different age groups (6-7; 8-9; 10-11; 12-13). They were given two 60 second rounds to shoot from five separate locations from the basket. Six Jaycee members including the Nebraska State Jaycee River Region Director helped organize and run the first Jaycee sponsored youth sporting event of the 2011 year.

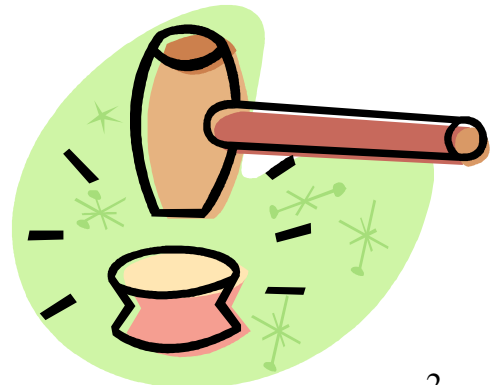

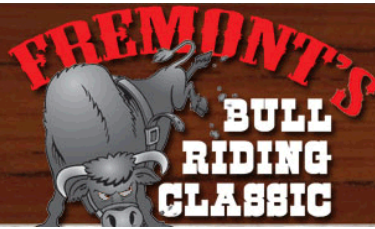
